



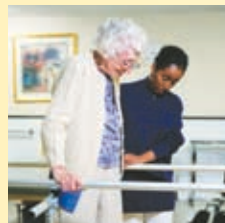
Overview

Directions to Lanessa Extended Care:

From Worcester

From Worcester, take Route 290 to Route 395. Take exit 1 off Route 395. Go straight at the end of the ramp onto Lake Parkway. Follow Lake Parkway to the end. Take a left onto School Street. The facility entrance is the third driveway on the left.

From Connecticut

Take Route 395 North to exit 1. Go left off the exit ramp on Thompson Road (Route 193). At the first set of lights, take a left onto Lake Parkway. Follow Lake Parkway to the end. Take a left onto School Street. The facility entrance is the third driveway on the left.

From Boston

Take Route 90 East (Mass Turnpike) to exit 10 (Auburn). After toll, take Route 395 South to exit 1. Go straight at the end of the ramp onto Lake Parkway. Follow Lake Parkway to the end. Take a left onto School Street. The facility entrance is the third driveway on the left.

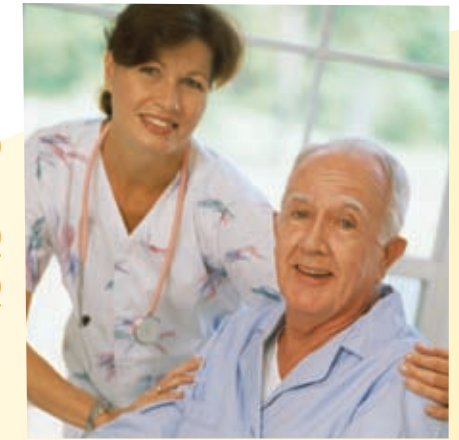

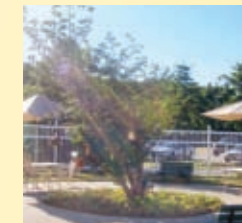
Mission
